The Golden Rules for a safe and pleasant cycling experience

ALWAYS RIDE ON THE LEFT-HAND SIDE



As a rule, bicycles are required to use the left side of the road.

MAKE A FULL STOP **AT INTERSECTIONS**



There are many traffic accidents at intersections as the streets in Kyoto city are laid out in a square grid. Make sure to stop fully at intersections, and check in all directions.

RULES FOR RIDING

PEDESTRIANS HAVE PRIORITY ON ALL SIDEWALKS. RIDE SLOWLY WHEN YOU RIDE ON SHARED SIDEWALKS.



YOU CAN RIDE YOUR BICYCLE ON THE SIDEWALK WHERE YOU SEE THIS SIGN.



You must stop completely and walk your bicycle when you are likely to get in the way of pedestrians.

FOCUS ON RIDING



Never use a mobile phone while riding.

Never use earphone or headphone while riding.

FINE APPLIES TO ALL OFFENDING **BICYCLES**

BICYCLE PARKING IS ILLEGAL ON KYOTO'S STREETS

- Please do not park your bicycle anywhere on Kyoto streets outside of the designated parking lots.
- Bicycles parked illegally will be removed and the owner (or renter) will be charged \u2300 to have it returned.
- Please abide by the rules to ensure all have a safe and enjoyable bicycle trip around Kyoto!
